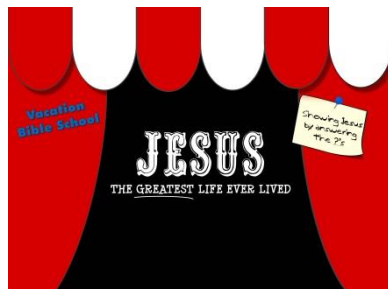
Winter 2019

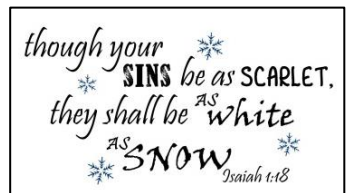
so much that He would, at His own expense, make a way of salvation so we can look forward to eternity with Him!
