

Give Thanks

A Storytelling Game of Thanksgiving

How to Make the Game:

- ★ Print the trivia cards on cardstock. Start by printing the ? card page 4 times, then print the trivia question pages on the backs of those four pages. Cut the cards apart.
- ★ Collect six different items to use as markers for each player/team to move around the game board. These could be coins, buttons, beads, etc.
- ★ Collect “treasures.” You will need five different objects, and enough of each object for each team to make a set. We used buttons, so we found six each of five different buttons for our treasure box.
- ★ Print the game squares on paper. You can make your game board simple by just gluing the squares on a rectangle of posterboard, or you can make a more lasting version by finding an old game board, covering it with scrapbook paper, gluing the game squares on, then cover the whole thing with contact paper.
Cut the game squares apart and arrange on your game board. The “Pick a Card” squares go in the four corners. “Start” goes near the middle of the bottom side, then directly above that build a “Home” road up into the center of the game board with the “Recite a favorite Bible Verse,” “Share the Story of Your Salvation,” “I Can’t Wait to Get to Heaven,” and “Home” squares. Arrange the rest of the squares in a path around the outside of the game board, making sure you don’t put more than one “Pick a Treasure” square and one “Give” square on a side. You can arrange your game board in a 6x6 square, a 7x8 rectangle, or any similar arrangement that fits your game board. (If you have extra squares, you can save them and if one square is used so much in a game that the players are tired of it, you can cover it with a new square.)
- ★ Print the instructions. If you used an old game board, you can glue the instructions inside the cover of the box. You can also print the game title to glue to the top of the box.
