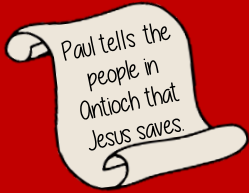


DECLARE THE NEWS



Lesson Overview

DAY 1: Notice! God Has Important News to Deliver



Text: Acts 13; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4

Objective: Students will understand that God has given us urgent news about Jesus!

Memory Verse: “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” Romans 6:23

DAY 2: Alert! People Need to Hear the News



Text: Acts 17:15-31

Objective: Students will understand that because we are all sinners, everyone needs to hear the news of salvation.

Memory Verse: “For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God” Romans 3:23

DAY 3: Danger! The Importance of the News



Text: Acts 23:12-35

Objective: Students will understand that God has provided a way to be saved from sin and reconciled to Him, but we have to believe!

Memory Verse: “But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8

DAY 4: Urgent! The News Must be Declared Now!



Text: Acts 26; Acts 9

Objective: Students will understand that God wants us to be ready to tell the news of salvation every time we have an opportunity.

Memory Verse: “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.” Romans 10:9

Bonus: “For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.” Romans 10:10

DAY 5: Onward! The Travel Map for Delivering the News



Text: Acts 27; Acts 28

Objective: Students will understand that wherever we are, there are people who need to hear the news of salvation.

Memory Verse: “For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.” Romans 10:13
